Sounds In Motion is a unique phonemic awareness and early literacy tool that utilizes body movements to develop the perception and production of speech sounds. It has been proven to help Kindergarten and 1st Grade children achieve literacy benchmarks in both **regular education and special education** classrooms.

Learning Outcomes:

Participants will be able to:

- Use body movements to enhance articulation stimulation, auditory perception and phonemic awareness.
- Demonstrate movements for 37 phonemes and be able to combine these into syllables and words.
- Integrate a hierarchy of listening skills into pre-k thru first grade academic programs.
- Introduce a SOUNDS IN MOTION program into regular, special education and early elementary classes
- Apply the SIM program as a Tier 1 – Response To Intervention.
